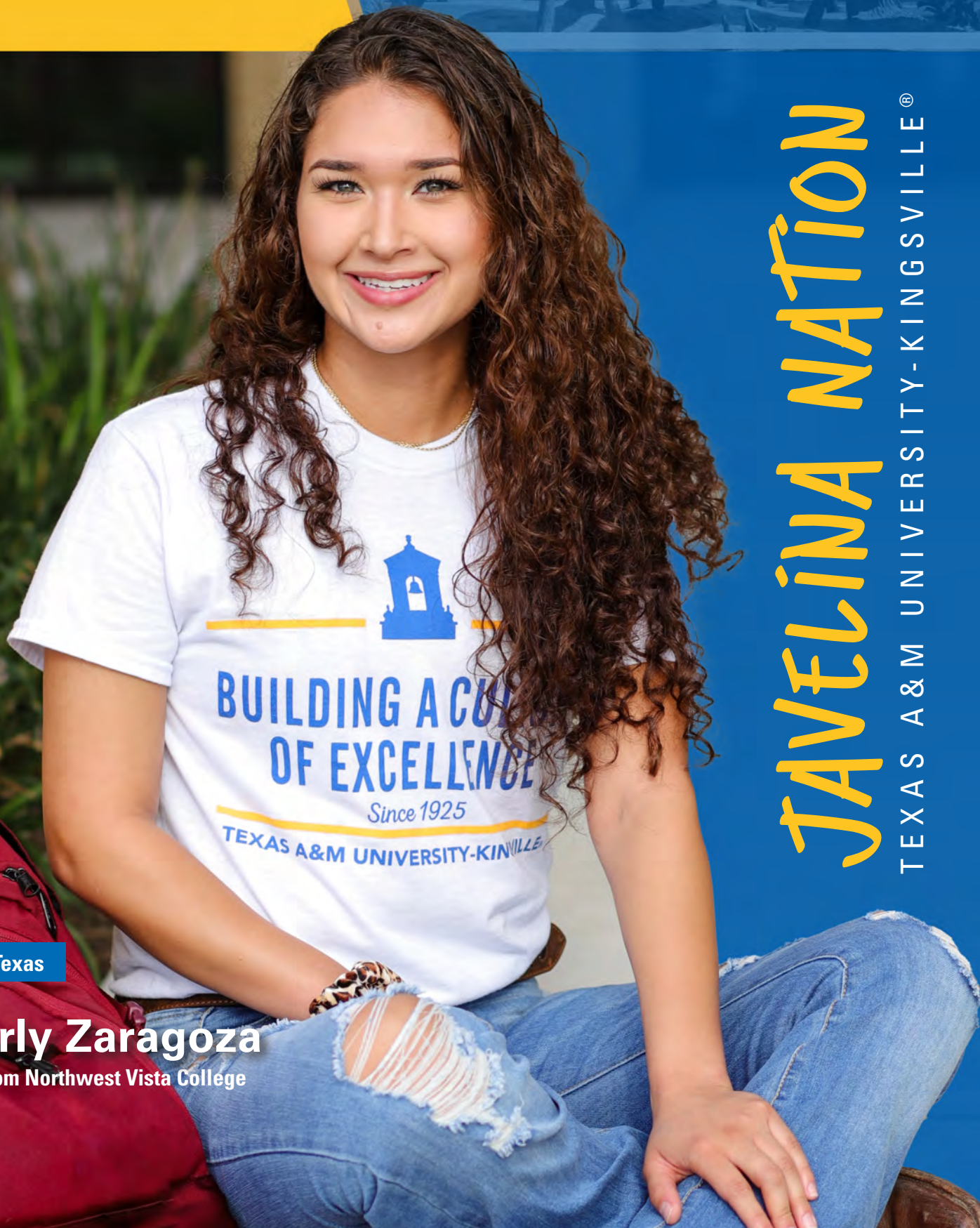

## SCHOLARSHIPS

### Transfer Excellence Scholarship

- Merit-based scholarships are awarded to new transfer students with outstanding academic qualifications (transfer GPA of 3.0 or higher).
- Scholarships are awarded based on information from admission application.
- No separate application is required.
- Award may be renewable based on availability of funding.

Javelina Promise is our pledge to ensuring a university degree is financially accessible to Texas students with a family income of **\$65,000** or less, and who demonstrate a financial need as determined by their FAFSA.

Tuition will be fully covered for transfer students based on the credits they need to finish their degree.

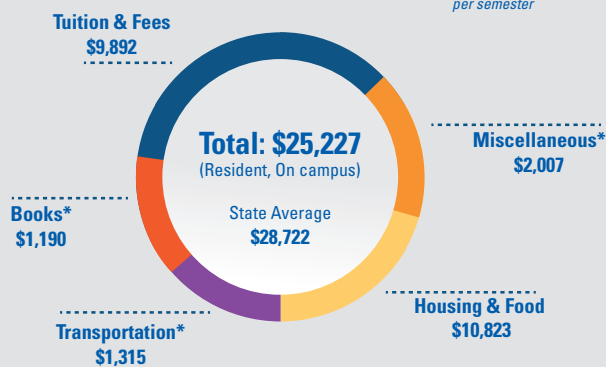
