If reinstatement is required for failure to file for program extension, you will need to submit the "Program Extension Request Forms" (completed by student and academic/graduate advisor). Forms available on ISSS website: . Submit all documents, listed, to the DSO in ISS. Note: A new I-20 will be issued for "Initial Attendance." You must depart and re-enter the U.S. by date indicated on Item #5 of the SEVIS I-20. Pay \$200 I-901 SEVIS Fee *prior* to re-entering the U.S. Payment can be made at www.fmjfee.com. **NOTE:** "You should be aware that the CBP officer will determine whether or not to admit you to the United States with the new Form I-20. *If you did not comply with the terms of your status during a prior* stay in the United States, the CBP officer may decide that you are not eligible to reenter."
