- Virtual and on-site attendance available (reside on campus for the 3-week period)
  - On-site program will include additional engineering and STEM-related activities

- US citizen or permanent resident
- Freshman, Sophomore or rising Junior status at Texas A&M-Kingsville or area community college
- GPA 2.0 or above
- minimum 18 years old
