Application for Mexican Citizens with Financial Need-Border County Waiver
Solicitud Para El Programa De Asistencia Estudiantil (PASE)

The **Border County Waiver**, known as the “PASE”, provides Mexican students, who are eligible, the opportunity to pay in-state tuition as if a resident of the State of Texas. Applicants must show documentation to prove personal or family financial need as determined by the Texas Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA). The duration of the PASE is for one academic year beginning in the Fall Semester and it covers the Spring Semester and Summer Term. There is no cost to submit this application.

Requirements Dictated by the State of Texas

1. Must be a citizen of Mexico or permanent resident of Mexico.
2. Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the TASFA.
3. Maintain a minimum academic cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better (undergraduates) and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better (graduates and doctoral) per semester.
4. Enroll on a full-time basis.

Application Procedures

- *Include the originals or copies of all the documents requested.
- *It will take approximately 3-4 weeks to process this application.
- *Review all the information to make sure it is accurate.
- *Please save a copy of all the documentation submitted.
- *The applicant will be notified by email concerning eligibility.

Deadlines for submission: July 1st for Fall, December 1st for Spring, and May 1st for Summer
