Pathways: How to Apply

All Pathways vacancies are posted on USAJOBS. (Note: The vacancies will not appear until they open on August 14, but you can prepare ahead of time!) To begin the process, follow these steps:

Do your research. Learn about the type of work performed at each of our [NASA facilities](#) so that you'll be able to find where you'd best fit at NASA based on your academic and career interests.

Prepare your application. Visit [USAJobs.gov](https://www.usajobs.gov) to create your profile, [build your resume](#), and set up a notification that will alert you when our positions open. *(TIP: To search for jobs even when you're not online, click the "Saved Searches" function in USAJOBS. Saved searches will automatically search for jobs based on your criteria and email you when there are new jobs available.)*

Apply to a vacancy during the open application window. Be sure to apply to the vacancy that corresponds to your academic major. In your application, you'll also need to identify which NASA center locations you're applying to.

Prepare for the Assessment: After you submit your application on USAJobs.gov, you may be asked (via email) to complete an online assessment.

NASA's Office of STEM Engagement (OSTEM) offers paid internships that allow high school and college-level students to contribute to agency projects under the guidance of a NASA mentor.

Applications for spring 2025 OSTEM internships are due August 23.

Please note: OSTEM applications are processed via a separate system than Pathways applications.
