Mandatory Language for a Monitoring & Reporting Violation

LEAD AND COPPER MONITORING

Texas A&M University Kingsville, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Chapter 30, Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to monitor for Lead and Copper and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ. During January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2014, we did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for lead and copper, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are working to correct the problem. The University will be taking the following measures:

Post notifications of the violation throughout campus
Finalize a list of buildings from which to take new water samples
Schedule the water sampling as per the TCEQ requirements

Please share this information with all people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.

Public Notice delivery timelines:

The initial public notice shall be issued as soon as possible, but in no case later than 90 days following the initial violation.

Repeat public notice shall be issued every 90 days for as long as the violation persists. All notifications require the attached Certificate of Delivery due 10 days from the posting date of the above notice.
