Registered Student Organizations Awards

1. Outstanding Greek Chapter Award

Awarded to an officially recognized fraternity or sorority in good standing under the jurisdiction of IFC/CPC that has demonstrated a commitment toward improving the quality of life at Texas A&M University-Kingsville through its events programs or services. Demonstrated the chapter's commitment to responding to the needs of students and the needs of the TAMUK community as a whole. Demonstrate the chapter's commitment to providing programs that promote interaction among the many different subcultures, both Greek and non-Greek, of the TAMUK community.

The receiving organization will be awarded \$250.

2. The President's Award

Awarded to an outstanding student organization that has demonstrated commitment to excellence and excels academically with an organization's overall GPA of 3.0. This organization holds events that aim to engage and educationally motivate students at TAMUK.

The receiving organization will be awarded \$500.

3. Outstanding Collaborative Effort Award

Awarded to a student organization that has demonstrated a commitment and effort toward working effectively with other student organizations and has been successful in planning a collaborative event.

The receiving organization will be awarded \$250.

4. Program of the Year Award

Awarded to a student organization for an outstanding social education, community service, or awareness program. Programs for consideration must have occurred between March 1, 2022, and March 1, 2023.

The receiving organization will be awarded \$250.

5. Impact Award

Awarded to a student organization that demonstrates a commitment to positive social change year-round. This student organization identified a problem, challenged injustice or inequality (on or off campus), and implemented a plan to make a difference in solving or addressing this need or concern.

The receiving organization will be awarded \$250.
